



GOLF COURSE RE-OPENING

COVID-19 PROTOCOL

The following protocol for the return of golf has been produced following Scottish Government advice and guidelines issued by Scottish Golf and R & A.

Please read the following carefully to familiarise yourself with the new “temporary” rules with regards play. These rules however may be amended as the ongoing situation and advice changes.

- DO NOT ACCESS THE GOLF COURSE IF YOU ARE EXPERIENCING ANY COVID-19 SYMPTOMS.
- ADVISE DPGC IF YOU EXPERIENCE ANY SYMPTOMS OF COVID-19 AFTER PLAYING.

We have built a new starters hut adjacent to the first tee. EVERYONE MUST CHECK IN AT THE STARTERS HUT BEFORE COMMENCING THEIR PRE-BOOKED ROUND. Drinks, snacks and bottled beers will be available for purchase.

SOCIAL/CASUAL GOLF ONLY, NO COMPETITIVE OR HANDICAPPING PLAY AT PRESENT.

BOOKING

- ONLINE BOOKINGS ONLY
- NO WALK ONS, NO EXCEPTIONS.

The club is required to maintain and retain tee booking sheets for the purposes of contact tracing by Scottish Government

- Maximum 2 ball playing groups
- All Players’ names must be entered on the booking sheet
- No bookings can be made at the starters hut

ARRIVAL FOR PLAY

- Only members with a pre-booked tee time to attend the club
 - Arrive at the club no more than 15 minutes prior to play
 - Drive to the rear car park only
 - Change and prepare equipment in car park
 - Make your way to the first tee 5 minutes before your tee off time to check in
 - Always adhere to social distancing
 - Practice areas will remain closed at this time
- There will be no buggy’s or trolleys for hire

DURING ROUND

- Normal course layout to be played
- Social distancing at all times • Carry personal hand sanitiser
 - Only touch own equipment/golf balls
 - Uplift own tees (including broken tees)

- Do not touch/remove flagstick - the holes have been altered for easy ball retrieval.
- Putt with the flagstick in and remove your own ball from the hole. Not every putt needs to be holed out in casual golf.
- With no rakes allowed on the course, golfers to make their very best efforts to smooth the sand using their club and/or their feet.
- Following play of a hole, do not enter the next teeing area until the all members of the group in front have played their tee- shots and exited the teeing area.
- If 18 holes have been booked, please return to your vehicle and await your second 9-hole tee off time
 - No sharing of equipment
- Leave the club immediately on completion of round

STARTER HUT

- Dalziel Park Hotel (including locker rooms) remain closed until further notice • Starter hut open 8am – 7pm
- Hand sanitiser available immediately outside starter hut
 - There will be no toilet facilities available

MEMBERSHIPS AND PAY PER PLAY

- We would encourage all members who have yet to complete their membership payment to do so before logging on to the booking system as you will not be granted early access and will not be able to make a booking as a member
- Pay per play remains £10 per 9 hole round Monday - Friday, £15 per 9 hole round Saturday & Sunday, £15 per 18 hole round Monday – Friday & £20 per 18 hole round Saturday & Sunday and as previously stated only two players for any tee off time
 - All players must check in at the starter hut before commencing play
